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
OUR SCHOLARS





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MEET OUR FAMILIES

The Pugh family has been part of the Compass family for four years. Their son, Zakary, is a fifth grade scholar in the Options program. A typical school day for Zak consists of Independent reading and writing,



online math lessons, and additional special education services including speech therapy and specialized academic instruction from a credentialed Compass special education teacher.

Zakary's mother, Randi Pugh, is a member of Compass' Parent Advisory Council and also serves on the El Dorado Charter SELPA's Community Advisory Committee. She shared that the main goal is for Zak to be able to pursue his dreams with a solid foundation of academics and life skills, and that Compass has helped create that foundation through their homeschooling program.

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MEET OUR FAMILIES

The Peart family is enjoying their first year at Compass. Their daughters are eighth grade scholars in the Online program.

A typical school day for their daughters usually starts around 9 am



and consists of attending all of their live, virtual learning labs with their teachers and peers. They also attend Q&A sessions with their teachers to receive additional support. The girls spend time working through the curriculum for each of their classes. Their family has found that having the girls study and learn in separate rooms at home to complete their lessons works best. They are grateful for the opportunity to do what works best for their daughters.

"Compass helps them achieve their goals by holding them accountable. The communication between parents and school staff is very helpful." - Terri Peart

Terri Peart shared that she enjoys knowing that her daughters are concentrating on school without all of the daily stress that comes with a brick-and-mortar school. For her daughters, being in the online program means there is no rushing to class several times a day, carrying a huge stack of books, or social distractions. Since enrolling at Compass, Terri noticed that her daughters get the total amount of work done in a shorter period of time. Her daughters complete their work on most days within 4-5 hours.

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
